Guideline for preparation for oral paper and electronic posters: Oral presentation

- Oral presentation must be prepared in English language on Microsoft PowerPoint (2007 or later version). Maximum slide number is 10, excluding the title slide.
- Title slide or the first slide of the presentation slide should contain: Title of the
 presentation, full name and designation of presenting author, name and affiliation of the
 co-authors and disclosure of conflict of interest, if any.
- Please maintain strict patient confidentiality.
- Structure of the oral presentation should be: Aims/objectives, methods, result, conclusion and take home message/practice consideration.
- We discourage animation/movies. Sound will not be supported. Please include static images only. File size of the entire presentation should not exclude 25 Mb.
- Please include relevant references as footnotes.
- Time allotted for oral presentation is for 8 min with 2 mins for discussion. Candidates exceeding time will not be considered for awards.
- Papers will be judged on originality, clinical relevance, clarity of presentation and quality
 of slides. Three prizes will be awarded for best oral papers.

Electronic poster

- Posters will be accepted and evaluated in two categories: Scientific exhibit and Educational exhibit. Prizes will be awarded on both categories.
- Poster should be prepared in English language on Microsoft PowerPoint (2007 or later version).
- Total slide number should not exceed 10 slides excluding title slide. Please include static images only. We discourage animation/movies. Sound will not be supported. File size of the entire presentation should not exclude 25 Mb.
- Title slide of the poster should contain: Title of the poster, full name and designation of presenting author, name and affiliation of the co-authors and disclosure of conflict of interest, if any.
- Please maintain strict patient confidentiality.
- Structure of the poster should be:
 - Scientific exhibit posters:

- o Aims/objectives, methods, result, conclusion and take home message.
- Educational exhibit posters:
 - Background, learning objectives, imaging findings/procedural details and Take home message.
- Please include relevant references as footnotes.
- Posters will be judged on originality, clinical relevance, and quality of content. Presenting authors maybe required to be present during the judging process.
