Guideline for abstract submission for oral paper and electronic posters:

- Last date of abstract submission: 15th September 2024.
- Date of confirmation of acceptance: 22nd September 2024.
- Abstracts are being invited for oral paper/ e-posters on topics relevant to Gastrointestinal and abdominal imaging and intervention.
- Registration to the conference is mandatory. Participants must quote registration number in abstract.
- Only online submissions are accepted.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English language only.
- Each author may submit a maximum of 2 abstracts (paper and/or poster) as a presenting author. If selected, certificate of presentation will be awarded to the presenting author only.
- Please use concise title for your abstract and avoid abbreviations.
- Oral paper/Scientific exhibit posters:
 - Abstract should be written with 250 words.
 - It should have the following headings: Aims/objectives, methods, result and conclusion.
- Educational exhibit posters:
 - Abstract should be written with 400 words.
 - It should have the following headings: Background, learning objectives, imaging findings/procedural details and Take home message. We encourage focused case series rather than single case reports.
- Do not include graphs/tables/figures/references in the abstract.
- Do not include identifying information such name of authors or institution in the body of the abstract.
- Submissions that are not in the prescribed format will not be accepted.
- Name of the presenting author needs to be clearly mentioned, if it is different from the submitting author. Maximum of 5 co-authors are allowed.

- No changes in the abstract contents and the authorship will be allowed after the final submission.
- On confirmation of selection, authors grant the organizing committee the right to publish the abstract in digital form.
- Decision of the abstract review committee will be final.
- Do not submit the same abstract for electronic poster and the scientific oral paper presentation. One of the duplicate abstract will be removed at the discretion of the scientific committee.
- If you wish to withdraw your abstract after the final date of submission, you must inform the scientific committee by email to support@isgar.org.
