

Guidelines for Abstract of Oral Research Paper presentation

- **Oral papers must constitute Scientific Research (data)** on Diagnostic / Interventional aspects of Gastrointestinal & Abdominal Radiology.
- **Please do not submit a single case report / Pictorial Review / Case series.**
- A maximum of 1 paper per presenting author will be accepted for submission.
- A paper that has been previously published / presented cannot be submitted.
- **Last date of abstract submission is 31st May 2026.**
- Presenting author can be postgraduate students / residents / fellows of Radiology / Practicing consultant Radiologists.
- **Abstracts shall be accepted from registered delegates only. Registration for the conference & workshop is mandatory before abstract submission.**
- Patient confidentiality should be protected. No names, hospital numbers, or any other identifying information should appear in the presentation. Presentation should include original images and not copied from the articles / web. **Submissions that fail to protect patient confidentiality & Submissions with plagiarized material will be disqualified.**
- Abstracts should be submitted online on ISGAR website in Microsoft word document / pdf file.
- **Only the top few accepted abstracts will be invited for oral paper presentation. The rest will be converted to E-posters. All accepted abstracts and E-posters will be honored with certificates.**
- **Decision of the review committee will be final.**
- Abstracts should not be more than 500 words (excluding the title, author list and institution).
- Abstracts should include sections on
 - Title, author list (max. 8 including presenting author) and hospital/clinic details of presenting author
 - Objectives
 - Materials and methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion(s)
 - A few images / relevant tables with legend may also be included (not included in word count)

Guidelines for E-poster presentation

- **E-posters can include Scientific Research / Pictorial Review / Case series** on Diagnostic or Interventional aspects of Gastrointestinal & Abdominal Radiology.
Please do not submit a single case report
- A maximum of 1 poster per presenting author will be accepted for submission.
- A poster that has been previously published / presented cannot be submitted.
- **Last date of e-poster submission is 31st May 2026.**
- **If you intend to submit your Scientific Research as E-poster, please include the entire relevant details of the research (not just abstract) in the poster - No modifications shall be accepted after last date of submission.**
- Presenting author can be postgraduate students / residents / fellows of Radiology / Practicing consultant Radiologists.
- Posters shall be accepted from registered delegates only. Registration for the conference & workshop is mandatory before poster submission.
- Patient confidentiality should be protected. No names, hospital numbers, or any other identifying information should appear in the presentation. Presentation should include original images and not copied from the articles / web. **Submissions that fail to protect patient confidentiality & Submissions with plagiarized material will be disqualified.**
- Posters should be submitted online as PowerPoint presentation on ISGAR website in .pptx format (Microsoft 2013 PowerPoint or a later version). Images / videos must be integrated into the PowerPoint file.
- **All presentations will be scrutinized and only the accepted e-posters will be displayed during the conference and given certificates. Best posters shall be selected for awards. All accepted abstracts and E-posters will be honored with certificates.**
- **Decision of the review committee will be final.**
- Posters should include sections on
 - Title, author list (max. 8 including presenting author) and hospital/clinic details of presenting author
 - Objectives
 - Materials and methods, Results, Conclusions, Discussion (For research studies)
 - Observations / Cases with figures +/- Discussion (Other than research studies)
 - Conclusion(s)
